Course selection

The ten-week quarter is short and intense, and can be challenging for students who are accustomed to semester terms.

Not every course is offered each quarter or each year. It might not be possible to enroll in your preferred courses. Be prepared to make alternative course selections.

Please note that these UC Davis courses will not be available to UC reciprocity students:

- Mechanical Engineering: (EME): EME 50 Manufacturing Processes
- Computer Science Engineering (ECS): ECS 150 Operating Systems & System Programming, ECS 193A Capstone Project, ECS 193B Capstone Project

Eligibility

To enroll in courses with prerequisites, you will need the assistance of the [academic department advisor](#) at the department offering the course.

You may enroll in undergraduate courses in the College of Engineering, provided you meet the prerequisites and there is space in class. Prerequisites are listed in the course descriptions in the [General Catalog](#).

Undergraduates may enroll in **graduate-level courses (numbered 200 and above)** only with permission from the course instructor.

Academic resources

Although the [UCD College of Engineering](#) website is designed for new students enrolling in degree programs, it contains a lot of information that may be of interest to you as well.

Through the [College of Engineering](#) website, you can find information about the various departments, facilities and faculty of the College.

Steps for enrollment success

- Review the [enrollment steps](#).
- Research courses in the [General Catalog](#) and use [Schedule Builder](#) or the [Class Search Tool](#) (also called the schedule of classes) to verify that the times and days of the classes and final exams do not coincide. The Schedule Builder will tell you:
 - the meeting times of the classes offered each term
 - the name of the instructor
 - the meeting place of a class and
 - the current enrollment status (how much space is left)
- [Prerequisite Checking](#)
Schedule Builder will check to see if you have completed the prerequisites for your planned courses. This automated function prevents registration in a class, unless the system finds an adequate prerequisite course has been taken or an instructor-approved petition is on file.
- Prerequisite Petition
Submit a Prerequisite Petition through [Schedule Builder](#) if the system does not recognize that the prerequisite is satisfied. Contact an advisor if you have questions about whether you meet the prerequisites for a course.

Lectures and sections

Note that many classes have primary (lecture) sections, as well as secondary (discussion or laboratory) sections.

Non-engineering courses

If you are unable to enroll on your own through [Schedule Builder](#), contact the academic advisor in the department that offers the course.
