Enrollment

You will manage your enrollment through [MyUCLA](#).

Microbiology, Immunology and Molecular Genetics (MIMG) course enrollment instructions:

- View the [Course Catalog](#) for course descriptions and check the [Schedule of Classes](#) to verify that the times and days of each course's class sessions and final exams do not coincide.
- Email MIMG advisors (undergrad@microbio.ucla.edu) to request enrollment, as specified in the [Prerequisite Clearance Request Form](#).
- Provide the course description for the home university course that you took as a prerequisite.
- If the course you are interested in has discussion sections, please include your discussion section preferences in order of priority.

Enrollment in specific courses cannot be guaranteed. Consult with your home university academic advisors and be prepared to select alternative courses.

Important Enrollment Policies:

- MIMG courses are restricted to students placed as MIMG majors during first and second pass enrollment.

- Students in other majors may request enrollment assistance from MIMG Advisors after second pass.
- Enrollment assistance is provided only when space permits.
- MIMG Advisors are not able to over-enroll courses or provide PTE numbers.
- Because enrollment is not guaranteed, students are encouraged to have back-up course options ready.

Do not wait until you arrive at UCLA. Classes will likely be full before the start of the term.

You must enroll in a minimum of 12 course units to remain in good academic standing. To fulfill this requirement, you will need to choose the remainder of your courses (one or two more) from other departments (e.g., history, English, area or ethnic studies courses, etc.).
